

#### Grade 1's

Numeracy: 80% of students will demonstrate age-appropriate Number Sense at a proficient or extending level.

**Reading:** 80% students will read at or above the target level, including individualized targets.

Writing: 80% of our students will be able to meet writing expectations for their grade level or their IEP.
