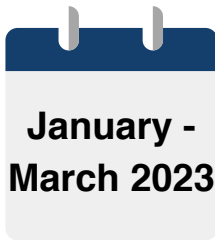

## Customized activities

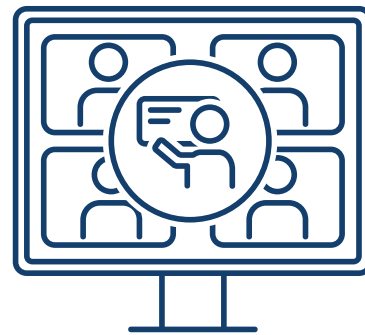


Grades
